



Graphics Checklist

Minimize delays and avoid unnecessary design fees – use our Graphics Checklist below to make sure you provide the Protocase Graphics Team with everything they need to prep your order so it can be built.

Graphic Files

- ✓ Provide vector files, not raster
- ✓ Accepted vector file types: .AI, .EPS, .SVG, .DXF and Vector .PDF
- ✓ Vector files should be 1:1, in order to prevent your file being altered when it is scaled

Fonts

- ✓ Provide your fonts when you send in your file.
- ✓ Alternatively, you can convert the text to outlines, saving it as a vector shape.
- ✓ Once a font is converted to outlines, the text can no longer be edited.

Other Tips

- ✓ Include all pertinent info on where you would like your graphics placed on your parts.
- ✓ Provide your artwork for the digital printer in CMYK color mode. If you're choosing silkscreen, you do not need to worry about color mode. You can simply pick which stocked silkscreen colors you wish to use.
- ✓ Make sure your version of Protocase Designer is up to date!
